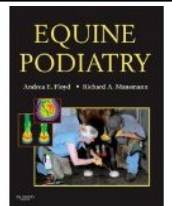
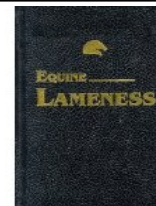
Jochen Schleese, CMS, CEE, CSFT
